Yolanda Green is a community pioneer, children’s advocate, seasoned public speaker and Emmy nominated television personality. In 1994 Green joined KIAH-TV Channel 39’s Public Affairs/Programming Department. In less than two years she rose to the position of Community Relations Director and Host of “Outlook Houston”. In 2000 Green became the driving force behind a comprehensive broadcast Public Service Campaign allowing children in foster care to be featured on Channel 39 resulting in more than 5,500 children finding adoptive homes.

In her current capacity, Green hosts “Outlook Houston” once per month and she has a weekly program “Going Green with Yolanda Green” which highlights businesses; commercial products, government programs and local initiatives making significant strides in ensuring our communities are eco-friendly. The program garnered eight Emmy nominations in its first two years of operation. Yolanda and her team have also received numerous honors and awards for their outstanding efforts to bring environmental issues to the attention of Houston and the surrounding communities.

As a public speaker, Green shares her powerful personal journey as a teenage mother, lessons in leadership and her vision for a stronger community one volunteer opportunity at a time. She imparts humor and inspiration while issuing a call to action in the individual and collective lives of her audiences.
